

Weathercock & Weathercock Chf Motion to Amend decree which
 was made on the bill and Answer on Consideration Whereof it
 is decreed and ordered that the commissioners Appointed by a
 former decree of this Court to lay off and divide the lands and
 Slaves which were of the decedent estate of Priscilla Weathercock
 do sell the same (it appearing to the Court by Consent parties
 that the same Catts not be divided among those entitled) on a Credit
 of 9 months taking bond and suff of the purchaser and divide the
 proceeds in the following manner to wit ^{Thos} Thos Weathercock 3/8
 of the amt of sales of the lands being allotted to 1/8 in his own right
 & the other 2/8 by the will of My and William Weathercock and that they
 apportion to Thos Weathercock 1/8 of the proceeds from the sales of the
 negroes and 2/8 of the proceeds of the negroes to Robt Good negro
 Thos as ad. of Wm Weathercock it being liable to the payment
 of the debts of Wm Weathercock - 1/8 of the sales of the lands
 & slaves to Kirby Battle and Lucy his wife one eighth to Ambrose
 Andrews his wife Sally one eighth to Rebecca Dickar one eighth
 My Jno Parsons Weathercock and Mason Weathercock to be equally divided
 between them & the remaining eighths to Francis Brister and
 Polly Sulphanne to be equally divided among them & make note
 Absent William Bly present Cain Bowers
 Harrison My Francis Little Clerk of Aug to Spiz Vento and the Sheriff
 having returned that he had levied the said tithes on sundry property
 seven head cattle 2. pots, skillet, Spinning wheel three chickens
 one feather bed without furniture one cow hide & calf and
 the debts being paid & not app^d therefore it is ordered that the
 Sheriff sell the same for Cash give due notice and with
 the proceeds pay and satisfy the said judgments
 On the motion of Wm Bly by his attorney to dismiss the bill of venue
 granted by Josiah Muddaugh to the an injunction & parties heard
 whereupon it is decreed and ordered that the same be dismissed the
 said Josiah Muddaugh having failed to give bond as is
 by law required &
