Thamper a free negro was set by the bar by the sheriff of this
County and charged with having on the day of September 1805
~~was on the day October 1805~~ a hog the property of John
Applumatis and on the day of October in the same year
a hog the property of Miles Carey feloniously killed and
carried away to which ^{and for his true punishment in his country} he pleaded not guilty, and thereupon
came a jury to wit, Winchen Pitts, Edwin Harris, William
Houghan, Henry Persons, Nathl. Pitts, Lewis Harris, Jesse
Williford, Dempsey Douglas, Simmons, Butler, Clifford
Hawell, Hawell, Scarper and Edmund Jagger who being sworn
tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the charge aforesaid and
the witnesses recognized appeared was sworn and examined touching
the premises the jury upon their oath do say that the prisoner is
guilty of the hog stealing whereunto he stands indicted and that
he incised 39 lashes on his bare back well laid on and that
the sheriff be the same performed and the sentence having
been read the pleaed that he be discharged
