Parker vs. Parker Chy. This cause was this day heard on the bill of the Compt. an consideration whereof it is decreed and ordered that Geo. Josiah Munday, Samuel Harrison & Mary Cobb Commissioners appointed by the Court to see and advise the estate of James Gardner dec'd. and each of them be enjoined and restrained from delivering over to Lucy Parker or any other person or persons for him or to his use any bond or writing respecting his wife's proportion of the estate of said James Gardner in right of his wife Penelope Parker late Penelope Gardner till the further order of the Court, that Theophilus Daughtery be also restrained and enjoined from paying over to the said Parker or any other person or persons for him any sum or sums of money due and demand on account of any purchase made by the s^d Daughtery at the sale of s^d property of James Gardner and more especially a bond which was given by the s^d Daughtery to s^d Commissioners payable to the s^d Lucy Parker and his wife Penelope Parker the sum of \$259.45 & that ^{Joseph Munday} ~~the said Daughtery~~ be appointed ~~trustee~~ ^{trustee} for the purpose of receiving said money due as aforesaid and applying it to the use of said Penelope provided the Court shall give just order to the s^d Lucy Parker in the suit commenced or to be commenced for her separate maintenance and that the trustee have power to liquidate & settle all such or differences between the s^d Parker wife
