 and Mass G free negro also being sworn and Joe a negro slave
 being charged were examined touching the premises then the
 prisoner heard by counsel in his defence the Court on consideration
 of the evidence and all the circumstances of the case were of
 opinion that the prisoner is ~~guilty~~ ^{guilty} therefore it is
 ordered that he be forthwith discharged out of custody
