Sail Wood who was heretofore committed to the custody
of the Jailor of this County was this day brought into
Court & set to the bar (after Court heretofore ~~been~~
^{for his examination} Summoned, not having met) and was examined for
stealing a parcel of corn the property of Wm
Peterson of Super County and divers witnesses appeared
to wit Geo Booth, Wyatt Barham & Simmons
& Hamilton Harris who were sworn and examined
on behalf of the Commonwealth and the prisoner
heard by Counsel. The Court after hearing the testimony
and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion
that the prisoner ought to be tried for the
offence at the next Superior Court to be holden
for this County on 7 Sep. next and their motion
of the prisoner by his Counsel it is ordered that
he be admitted to bail ^{with 2 Sureties} in the sum of 300
dollars before two Justices of the peace and until
then he remanded to Jail.

Be it remembered that George Booth, Wyatt Barham,
Alfred Simmons & Hamilton Harris, here in Court set
themselves to be instituted unto his excellency James Barber
Esq. Governor of this County for the time being and his
Successors in office in the sum of three hundred & thirty three
dollars & thirty four cents ^{each} to be living of their respective lands
and tenements goods and chattels yet on this condition that
if the said George Booth, Wyatt Barham, Alfred Simmons
and Hamilton Harris shall personally appear
before the Judge of said Sup. Ct at the Court
house on the 7 of Sep next by 10 o'clock
