to be tried for this 1st offence at the next

November next the court being of opinion
that the sheep by him stolen is worth of
the value of 4 Dollars on motion of Attorney to be admitted
to be admitted to bail the court are of opinion that he be admitted to
bail for the sum 100 dollars 50 dollars or 50 dollars each.

Be it remembered that Richd Buck Widow Scott
Scott personally came into court and asked them
selves and ad of them asked themselves to be indebted
to Jas Buchanan Esq Gov. of Va on the sum of
393 3/4 Cents each of them respective lands
and tenements goods chattels to be levied to the
use of the Court rendered yet upon this Court
that if the 1st Richd Buck Widow Scott shall
personally appear before the justice of said
county Court on the 3 Monday in November
by 10 o'clock then & there to give such evidence
as they will each of them to and Wm Brown
shall not depart without leave of the Court
from this recognizance to be paid
