 on the Cypress Swamp and it appy from that
 Inquisition the stagnation of the water will be
 injurious to the health of the occupants of
 the lands belonging to Thomas Stanley therefore
 it is Ordered that the petition be dismissed and
 the writ Quashed

Ordered that the court be adjourned till Court in Council.
