On motion of Jacob Danson for reimbursement of money paid by him on land which he owned previous to the 1st day June 1812 Ordered that he have Indgt. for the following sum to wit, Eighty three cents for the tax of Int. on a tract of Land sit^d in the name of John McCabe & two shillings & fifty two cents the tax of Int. on a tract of land returned in the name of Jesse Gardner of Salsma for the non payment of taxes thereon -

On the motion of Edwin Gray the collector of attorney's moneys on behalf of the U.S. here in court acknowledging legal notice of the same It is ordered by the court that in addition to the facts heretofore ordered to be certified in the said Gray's petition setting forth that he had incurred a fine for forfeiture openally in having commenced stilling with five stills on the first day of January 1814 the capacity of which 5th still has not been ascertained that he applies to the collector ^{as soon} as he was informed that one had been appointed in the 15th collection district & informed him of the circumstances for leave on his said five stills, but was refused a license except to commence from the date of his application, that the capacity of the five stills, so as aforesaid used for the stillation of spirits by the said Edwin Gray, ^{as it} appear
