-ard David Woodard, Charles Woodard, William Woodard, John
Woodard, Elizabeth and Amy Woodard, heirs of the said
William Woodard dec^d reserving nevertheless to Elizabeth
Woodard the widow of the said W^m Woodard dec^d her dower
right in the same, and it is decreed that the com^{pt}
James Millikin, do make a good & sufficient deed of
conveyance in fee simple to the aforesaid tract of land
