Governor of this Court of his decession in office for the time being the said Benjamin Britte who stands bound for his wife Peggy Britte in the sum of One hundred dollars and the said Joshua Frost and David Council in the sum of fifty dollars each to be lived of their respective lands & tenements goods & chattels and to the use of the Court renewed - Yet upon this condition that if the said Peggy Britte shall personally appear at the Court house of this County on the first day of the Court to be holden in the month of May next to answer the Court of those things whereof she stands charged & shall not report hence without leave of the Court then this recognizance to be void
