On the motion of James Battle the attorney for the Court being present for to be exonerated from the pay^t of taxes ^{for the year 1805} ~~for the year 1805~~ ^{in the name of James Battle which he pays} for the non pay^t of taxes for the year 1805 he having proved to the satisfaction of the court that the said land is not so in arrears it is ordered that he be exonerated from this pay^t of said taxes ^{thereof}.

Like a negro man slave the property of John Breen was this day set to the bar by the Sheriff ^{of this county} into whose custody he was hitherto committed and charged with stealing taking & carrying away from the house of John Barham on the 24th of April last ^{a quantity of} past^r the court summoned for his examination not having met and thereupon seven witnesses appeared on behalf of the Court (to wit) John Barham, Wm Barker & Edward Reese who being sworn & examined touching the premises ^{the witness readily answer} the court after hearing the testimony of all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner is guilty and that he is entitled to the benefit of Clergy. Therefore it is ordered that he be bound in the sum of ^{£100} 30 ^{to keep the peace} and the same being performed & proclamation being made as the manner is & nothing further appearing or being alleged ag^t him it is ordered that he be forthwith discharged.
