Due by bill penal. Therefore it is considered that the debt have been paid agt the debt for the same, and it appearing to court from the examination of John Brister Garnishee in this case that he has in his possession a note executed by John Stephenson to Saml Pond the debt bearing date the 11th of May 1816 payable on or before the 25th Dec next after the date thereof the principal & interest of which note amounts at this day to \$28.33 and which said note was assigned by said Saml Pond to John Brister and the said John Brister acknowledging that he hath no interest in the same. It is therefore ordered by the court that the said John Brister assign the said note to the said John Ingubant in part payment of the debt due as aforesaid from the aforesaid Saml Pond, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the court by the acknowledgment of said John Brister that he will be indebted at the end of the year to said Saml Pond in the sum of \$25 for the rent of a plantation of the said Saml Pond & probably in a greater sum.
