The Court being thus constituted, and the prisoner appearing at the bar at the appointed time according to his recognizance entered into before a Single Justice of the Peace, charged with the offence of Murder of Jeffery a negro Slave as aforesaid, whereupon divers witnesses being called, to wit Messrs. Marmble, James D. Mapenburg - latter Counsel for Henry Guley who appearing, were sworn, on behalf of the Commonwealth and examined touching the premises, and the prisoner being fully heard by Counsel learned in the Law - Whereupon the Court after hearing all the testimony, as well the circumstances touching the case, are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for the murder whereof he stands charged, in the Superior Court of Southampton County as he holds in and for the said County, on the first day of Sept^r next, and the Court being of opinion that the prisoner may be bailed himself in the sum of One Thousand dollars and two Securities each in the sum of five hundred dollars & Whereupon the said Thos. Jones with James D. Mapenburg and Nathl. Muesum his Securities, here in Court acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto his Excellency

James D. Presto the said Thos. Jones the said James Sum of five hundred dollars goods and his Securities upon this Court makes his application to the Court at the Court Judgment of leave of the Court in full force

But it is Commanded as to be issued Chief magistrates each in the sum of five hundred dollars, for this Condition then appeared at the Court and then and on behalf of the said Jeffery a negro Slave the Court of the Court in full force
