

On the motion of Rich^d. P. Clements - It is ordered that the order of August court last appointing S^r. Rich^d. P. Clements & John M. Simon to see the land proceedings is impunct. At 18 he resigned and that Matthew Parker & John M. Simon be appointed in their stead -

Joseph Wright late of the county of Southampton was this day set to the bar by the Sheriff of this county into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with Burglariously breaking & opening the staple of the barn door of Jesse Pracey of the said county, and thence stealing, taking & carrying away, one stone jug of the capacity of one half gallon partly full of apple brandy on the 27th of Nov^r. last (the court summoned for his examination not having met)

And thereupon oaths were sworn & examined on behalf of the court tending the premises to wit, Esjington Soyner and ~~Matthew~~ ^{James} Mountfort - The court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for the said offence at the next Superior court to be holden for this county

Esjington Soyner ^{James Drake Jesse Pracey} & ~~Matthew~~ ^{James} Mountfort here in court acknowledge themselves indebted unto his excellency Thomas M. Randolph Esq. Governor or Chief magistrate of this comm^{ty} & his Successor in office for the time being in the sum of \$333.33 1/3 cents to be levied of their respective goods & chattels land & tenements & to the said Governor for the use of the comm^{ty}. undid - But upon this condition that if the S^r. Esjington Soyner & ~~Matthew~~ ^{James Drake Jesse Pracey} Mountfort shall personally appear before the Judge of the ^{next} Superior court to be holden for this county on the first day of the next term by 10 o'clock of that day then & there to give such testimony as they & each of them know or believe of the comm^{ty}. agt. Joseph Wright who stands charged with Burglary & shall not depart thence without leave of the court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force -

It is ordered that the accounts of Rich^d. P. Clements late shiff of this county amounting to \$17.66 cents be certified to the auditor of public accounts for his examination & pay

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
