James Blythe vs Thomas Brock - Upon a warrant to recover the possession of a certain tenement containing by estimation 37 - acres of land with the appurtenances lying & being in the county of Southampton - It appearing that the said warrant hath been duly executed according to the provisions of the above recited act of assembly, and that ^{John Clayton} ~~Benj^m Jerny~~ three Justices of the peace have been duly notified as required by the said act, and also that eighteen good and lawful men freeholders have been summoned as required by the said act. It is ordered that a Jury of twelve be taken by lot from the said freeholders whereupon came a Jury selected by lot to wit: Daniel Vick, Elias Vick, Joseph Lane, Saml. Posing, John Edwards, Bathrop Pond, John Vaper, Eley Soyner, David Constanphen, Saml. Monell, Matthew Soyner, James Milleding, who being charged on the said act of assembly requires returned a verdict in the words following to wit: ~~and by consent of parties by their attorneys Daniel Vick one of the Jurors in this case is withdrawn and the rest of the Jury from rendering a verdict in this case are discharged~~
"We the Jury find that the defendant viz ^{at} the time of the petition of the complaint filed in this cause, held possession of the tenement therein mentioned against the consent of the plaintiff, that the said Defendant hath so held possession thereof against the consent of the plaintiff, within three years next before the petition of the said complaint, and that the plaintiff hath the right of possession in the tenement aforesaid - Therefore It is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant possession of the tenement aforesaid, and his costs by him in this behalf expended, and a writ of habere facias possessionem is awarded him returnable here &c.
