

At a ~~court~~ court summoned and held for the county court of Southampton
at the courthouse on the 16th day of August 1820 for the punishment
of Nicholas Faincloth, who stands charged with feloniously stealing, taking
and carrying away ^{virginia} a bank note of five Dollars ~~on the bank of the~~
(belonging to one Sylvia Bryant), on the 30th day of July 1820
Present: Jeremiah Cobb, Law: book, Clementy Rochelle,
Mr. L. Everett & Mrs. E. Daughtrey Gent.

The court being then constituted, the prisoner was set at the bar by the
Sheriff of this county into whose custody he was heretofore committed, and
charged with the felony aforesaid, and thereupon given witness was
sworn and examined on behalf of the commd. touching the premises to wit,
Sylvia Bryant, Thomas Bryant, James Gray, Belah Elsworth, James
A. Barham, Anthony Woodard,

and the prisoner being fully heard by the court. — The court after
hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of
opinion that the prisoner ~~and of opinion that the prisoner~~ ought to be
tried for said offense at the next Superior court to be holden for this
county and thereupon it is ordered that he be remanded to said —

It is remembered that Sylvia Bryant, Thomas Bryant, James Gray, by
their next friend Sylvia Bryant, Belah Elsworth, James A. Barham and
Anthony Woodard here in court acknowledge themselves indebted unto his
Excellency Thomas M. Randolph Esq. Governor or chief Magistrate of this
Comm. and his Successors in office for the time being in the sum of
\$333.33/3 to be levied of their goods and chattels land & tenements respec-
tively and to the said Governor for the use of the commd. issued —

Yet upon this condition that if they the said Sylvia Bryant,
Thomas Bryant, James Gray, Belah Elsworth, James A. Barham,
and Anthony Woodard shall personally appear before the Judge of
our Superior court of Southampton county at the courthouse on the
first day of the next Superior court to be holden for this county
by 10 O'clock of that day, then and there to give such testimony as they
and each of them know on behalf of the commd. against Nicholas Faincloth
who stands charged with larceny & shall not depart thence without
leave of the court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain
in full force —
