Eley vs Eley Attachment. Ret? Exec? on the goods & chattels of Mills Eley and this second of Meade M Eley & Thomas Pond who were summoned as garnishes in this case of whom the said Thomas Pond reported that he was the trustee in a deed from the said Mills Eley to the said Meade M Eley which is filed in this cause & that he knows nothing of the consideration of the said deed or any fact concerning it except \$80 which he saw paid, & the said Meade M Eley reported that he held the property in said deed under the same & the plt claiming the sd property alleging that the said deed was fraudulent & having proved that the claim mentioned in his attachment was just The said Meade M Eley therefore filed his interpleader claiming the said property & the plt took issue thereon, whereupon it is considered by the court that the plt recover against the Deft The sum of \$262.56 with Int from the 22nd July 1820 till paid & the costs & It is ordered that the sheriff of this county make sale of the said property & apply the proceeds thereof towards the said and the trial of the issue in this case is continued till the next court.
