Alexander Booth of full age being sworn deponent and saith that he saw the prisoner at the bar at a preaching at Dipon Baps and since James Powell's home was burnt and saw him have 75 or 87 1/2 cents in silver

Dipon Baps of full age being sworn deponent and saith that he saw the prisoner at the bar at a preaching at his home since James Powell's home was burnt & saw the prisoner at the bar have a small quantity of money

John Deews of full age being sworn deponent and saith that he heard the prisoner at the bar say that if James Powell whipped him very often that the prisoner would not live with him. He also heard him say that if he was a Negro owner he would have the property of Mr. Lawrence being charged & sworn saying that during the last year he frequently heard the prisoner at the bar say that if James Powell whipped him that he would be wanted if he the prisoner did not kill him

The evidence on the part of the crown being thus closed and the prisoner being fully heard by counsel, the court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are unanimous of opinion that the prisoner is guilty of the murder of his master and is charged with the same

The court ordered that the prisoner be committed to the prison and that he be kept there until the 15th day of August next between the hours of 10 o'clock A.M. and 5 o'clock P.M. of that day and then if there be no change by the next tide he is read - read - read -
