Carolina and said he went away for fear the white people would be worrying about & catch him because he went in Dr. Valance's store & that the prisoner had 3 or 4 dollars in silver & that this deponent gave information and assisted in apprehending the prisoner

Peter a negro man slave the property of William Vick of full age being sworn & charged said that he saw the prisoner at the bar, and the prisoner told this deponent that he the prisoner had some money which he wanted counted & wished this deponent to get some person to count it, that this deponent got a negro man who could count money to go and count it & while they were counting the money this deponent with Matthew gave information and had the prisoner apprehended -
