John Harris & Jeremiah Cobb or any two of them view the convenience & inconvenience which will result as well to the public as individuals by turning the road called Bailey, Road leading from Proctors road to Broadwater road & make report thereof to this court according to duty.

On the motion of Joseph Britts - It is ordered that Mr. Cobb do examine State & settle an acct. out of Mrs. Britts adm^r on Joseph Ingham Esq. & report.

On the motion of John Gray - It is ordered that Mr. Gray do examine State & settle an acct. out of Mrs. Gray adm^r on Ethl. Washington Esq. & report.

On the motion of John Gray. It is ordered that Mr. Gray do examine State & settle an acct. out of Ethl. Washington adm^r on John Gray Esq. & report.

Ordered that John Danson, Benj^m Griffin, James D. Mapenbury, Henry Briggs, Esq. and James Rochelle, examine into the present state of the public building in Sermalem, and report to this court the state of repair & what further ^{repairs} or improvements are in their opinion necessary for the public safety & convenient administration of Justice &c.

Ordered that Mr. Dundy & Parkham Wren, be summoned to November court next to shew cause if any thing why they should not be fined for failing to attend this court as Grand Jurors when summoned according to duty.
