Touching the premises to which Henry Parker of full age being sworn deposeth & saith that on the 10th of July last past he this respondent was sent for by George Hines, then when this respondent got to Hines he informed this respondent that his smoke house was broken open and sent to have some slaves apprehended ^{in the neighbourhood}, who he suspected, & on the day after this respondent went again to Geo. Hines & sent for the same slave, the person who was sent caught this ~~officer~~, whose dress was greasy & very suspicious, the prisoner was then taken out and with small cords suspended by the thumbs for about one minute but the prisoner made no confession, he was then tied by the toes & drawn up but not entirely off the ground, but made no confession, he the prisoner was then put in the care of some young men for safe keeping till the next morning at which time they thought they could make further discovery and on the next day this respondent went again to the house of said Geo. Hines about 12 O'clock & during that evening the prisoner confessed that he broke the smoke house of Geo. Hines & took thereout the bacon & said it was at the house of his wife where this respondent with others went & found the bacon in the place where the prisoner said he had put it and further this respondent saith not.

Thomas Simmons of full age being sworn deposeth & saith that he was sent for by Geo. Hines to go to his home, when he this respondent got there he found the prisoner in custody & on the next day this respondent again went to Geo. Hines when the prisoner was then in custody & upon examination the prisoner confessed that he did break the smoke house of George Hines & take the bacon thereout & told where it was and this respondent with others went & got the bacon from where the prisoner said it was and further this respondent saith not.

Pick^r. Hines of full age being sworn deposeth & saith that he assisted in apprehending the prisoner who was carried to Geo. Hines and heard the prisoner acknowledge that he broke the smoke house of Geo. Hines & took the bacon thereout & told where it was & further this respondent saith not.

Henry Freeman of full age being sworn deposeth & saith that the smoke house of Geo. Hines was broken open on the 2nd of July last that he this respondent assisted in apprehending the prisoner who was suspended by the thumbs but made no confession of guilt but on the next day confessed that he the prisoner broke
