At a case cont. summons and held for the county of Southampton on the 3^d day of December 1828 for the examination of Harrod Dole, who stands charged with stealing, taking and carrying away five sheep the property of David S. Boykin of the value of Ten Dollars from the possession of the said David S. Boykin on the 22^d day of June last past

The court being then constituted the prisoner was set to the bar by the Sheriff of this county into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with the felony aforesaid, and thereupon divers witnesses were sworn & examined on behalf of the com^{ty}. Touching the premises, to wit David S. Boykin, and the prisoner being fully heard by counsel - The court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for said offence at the next Superior court to be holden for this county -

It is remembered that David S. Boykin here in court acknowledges himself indebted unto his Excellency Thomas M. Randolph Esq. Governor of this com^{ty} and his Successor in office for the time being in the sum of \$333.33 1/3 cents to be levied of his proper goods, chattels, lands and tenements, and to the said Governor for the use of the com^{ty}. rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said David S. Boykin shall personally appear before the Judge of our Superior court of S. C. on the first day of the next term of said Superior court by 10 O'clock of that day then & there to give such testimony as he knows on behalf of the com^{ty} against Harrod Dole & shall not depart thence without leave of the court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue -

It is remembered that Harrod Dole with Sipe Bailey & Patrick Dole here in court acknowledges themselves indebted unto His Excellency Governor of this com^{ty} & his Successor in office for the time being in the sum of \$1000 and his said Sec^{ts} in the sum of \$500 each to be levied of their respective goods and chattels, lands & tenements to the said Governor for the use of the com^{ty}. rendered - Yet upon this condition that if the said Harrod Dole shall personally appear before the Judge of the Superior court of this county at the court house on the first day of the next

Term by ten O'clock of the said court & shall not depart thence without leave of the court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue -
