Ordered that the estate of Samuel Turner be exempt from the payment of taxes in future for negroes Lydia & Bridget they being aged & infirm —

Mr. A. Holley produced to the court the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by law on hawkers or pedlars — Therefore it is ordered that he have leave to retail good wares & merchandise as a hawker & pedlar of good wares & within this condition the 30th of April 1822

Ordered that Alexander P. Pate procure weights & measures ^{for this county} in pursuance of an act of assembly in such case made and provided & that he keep the same, subject to the further order of this court —
