The court being then constituted the prisoner was del^{ivered} to the bar by the ^{Sheriff} of this county into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with the felony aforesaid and being thereof arraigned and upon his arraignment pleaded not guilty & for his trial put himself upon his God and this court and thereupon ^{given} witness were sworn and examined on behalf of the comm^{on} Touching the premises to wit John Harris, and the prisoner being fully heard by counsel
