At a court summoned and held for the county of Southampton on the
15th day of July 1822 for the examination of Rowlin Wood who stands
with feloniously stealing taking and carrying away on the night of
the 6th of this present month from & out of the possession of Brittain
Travis his hire & retaining money and being the property of the said
Brittain Travis -

The court being thus constituted the prisoner was led to the bar by
the Sheriff of this county into whose custody he was heretofore committed
and charged with the felony aforesaid and thereupon given witnesses
were sworn & examined on behalf of the com^t. Touching the premises
to wit, Donald Atkin and John Travis - and the prisoner being fully
heard by counsel, the court after hearing the testimony and all the circum-
stances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner ~~is~~ is guilty of
the petit larceny whereof he stands charged, therefore it is considered that
he be tried for said offence at the next quarterly term of this court and
thereupon it is ordered that he be remanded to jail -

It is remembered that Donald Atkinson here in court acknowledged
himself indebted unto his Excellency Thos. M^t. Randolph Esq^r. Governor or chief
magistrate of this com^t. & his succession in office for the time being in the
sum of \$233.33 1/3 cents to be levied off his goods & chattels lands & tenements
& to the said Governor for the use of the com^t. rendered - Yet upon this
condition that if the said D. Atkinson shall personally appear before the
Justices of the county court of Southampton at the courthouse on the first
day of August next day 10 o'clock of that day then and there
