The court being thus constituted the prisoner Matthew Gardner appeared in  
causes according to the condition of his recognizance and thereupon the security  
for his appearance from their recognizance and undertaking in this behalf  
are discharged and the said Matthew Gardner was committed to the custody  
of the Sheriff of this county and being set to the bar <sup>was</sup> charged with the  
felony aforesaid and thereupon divers witnesses were sworn and examined  
on behalf of the comm<sup>d</sup>. Touching the prisoners to wit, Harry Rawly,  
Tyler Edward, Polly Barnes, Rebecca Hatfield, John Blythe, and the prisoner  
being fully heard in his own defence, the court after hearing the circumstances  
of the case are unanimous of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for  
said offence at the next Superior court to be holden for this county &  
thereupon it is ordered that he be committed to the jail of this county  
and there to remain till he is discharged by one cause of law.

Be it remembered that Harry Rawly, Tyler Edward, Polly Barnes, Rebecca  
Hatfield, and John Blythe here in causes acknowledge themselves indebted unto  
his Excellency Thomas M<sup>r</sup> Randolph Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor or chief magistrate of  
this comm<sup>d</sup> & his Successors in office for the time being in the sum of \$333.33<sup>1/3</sup>  
each to be levied of their respective lands & tenements good & chattels & to the said  
Governor for the use of the comm<sup>d</sup> rendered - Let upon this condition that  
if they and each of them shall personally appear before the Judge of the  
Superior court of Southampton county at the comthouse on the first day of  
the next term of said Superior court by ten o'clock of that day then and  
there to give such evidence as they and each of them know on behalf  
of the Commonwealth against Matthew Gardner who stands charged  
with murder & shall not depart thence without leave of the court then  
this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue -
