On the motion of George Hines late Sheriff of the county of Southampton into whose hands the estate of Thomas Mason decd. hath been committed for administration - It is ordered that he rent out the plantations and hire out the negroes whereof the said Thomas Mason was seized & possessed instead of keeping up the plantations as directed by the will of the said Thomas Mason. It appearing to the satisfaction of the court it would be to the interest of the legatee to rent & hire the same as aforesaid.
