- Littleberry Mason is by the court appointed surveyor of the road from the state line near Boykin Bridge to the fork of the road at Burrville Bryant in the room of Mrs. Philips dec.
- Mrs. D. Philips orphan of Mrs. Philips dec. chose Mrs. Lee his guardian who gave bond & secy.
- Ordered that Clement Rockle, Will. Wrenble, Mrs. L. Ewate & John D. Hunt or any 4 let the repairs of the upper Swamp ^{bridge} near dam.
