Lewis Morrell the g^r armished appeared and being sworn. saith that as Adm^r of Polly Whitfield the mother of the deft. and if upon the settlement of his Adm^r Account a balance should be due the estate he is willing to pay the deft. proportion of such balance or so much of such balance as will be sufficient to the satisfaction of the pl^{ff} claim. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the pl^{ff} recover against the said deft. \$15 with Int. from 22^d May 1817 till paid & the costs. and that the said Lewis Morrell pay towards the satisfaction of this judgment the amount which may be in his hands due the deft or so much thereof as may be sufficient. &c
