from January 1/1830. and judgment for the same with costs &c.

Moyler for & n Felt. 40th & Case. Jury. to try the issue to wit. (the same jury
as in the last case), returned a verdict for the plaintiff for \$25. with int from the
1st Jan'y 1829 till paid & judgment for the same & costs. and the plaintiff agrees to
allow the debt any offset which he may make appear to be just.
