 ordered that the said Reilly be permitted to sell so many of the slaves allotted to the Widow of
 the said Nathaniel Wilkinson dec'd. as will be sufficient to raise a sum equal to the amount
 which the said Reilly has advanced for the said Estate &

Ordered that Clements Rochelle shff & out of any contingent moneys in his hands not
 otherwise appropriated pay to Edward Wills the sum of \$29.30 cents for the repairs and
 to Bridge below Moberburgs Mill &

Honell Reed still proved by Levi Waller one of the witnesses thereto the Executor therein
 named appeared in Court & refused to take upon himself the burden of the Estate of said Will.
 On the motion of Silas Sumner dec'd. of Mary Blunt dec'd. or Jane Blunt Exec of Rich^d
 Blunt dec'd. for Counter Security. the sum awarded at the last Court not being returned caused
 by a new sum is awarded returnable to the next Court.

Ann B. Whitehead orphan of Mellicam Whitehead dec'd. appeared in Court & chose Mrs.
 Whitehead for her Guardian & that upon the said Whitehead gave bond & security according to law.
