Benjamin Lewis who stands charged on oath by Mary Felt single woman of this County with being the father of her Bastard child thus appeared in Court in discharge his recognizance. and the said Mary Felt being fully heard on oath It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the said Benjamin Lewis is the father of the said Bastard child <sup>and that the said child is likely to become chargeable to the County</sup> Therefore It is ordered that the said Benjamin Lewis find security for the maintenance and support of said Bastard child for the term of Seven years from this time, if the said child should live so long himself in the sum of one hundred & forty dollars and two securities in the sum of seventy dollars each and in default thereof that he be committed to jail - Whereupon the said Benjamin Lewis with John W. Mason & John Shepherd his securities have in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to John Floyd Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Benjamin Lewis in the sum of \$140. and the said John W. Mason & John Shepherd in the sum of \$70 each of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be divided and to the Overseers of the Poor of this County to be rendered. But upon the condition that if the said Benjamin Lewis shall pay to the Overseers of the Poor of this County the sum of \$20. annually for the <sup>support of the</sup> said child for the term of seven of seven years from this day in case the said child shall live so long then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force. -
