The Commissioners appointed at the last Court to examine and report what repairs
are necessary to be done to the public building in Jerusalem, and what will be
the probable cost of such repairs and also of enclosing the public square this day
made their report which is ordered to be recorded. And it is ordered that the magis-
trates of this County be summoned to the next Court next to take into consideration

the said report.

On motion Spradley Williams who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the tax
imposed by Law. a license is granted him to keep an Ordinary at his house in
this County till the first day of May Court next upon his giving bond with
security according to Law. The Court being of opinion that the said Spradley Wil-
iams is a man of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming
