A majority of the acting Magistrates of this County being present the Court proceeded to consider the advice of Council to the Clerk of this Court directed bearing date ^{Executive} the 29th of June 1831 "came to the following Resolutions. 1st That the Clerk of this Court do certify to the Governor the names of all the magistrates that were present at the last Court when proceeded to the Recommendation persons to be appointed and been imposed Justice of the Peace for this County - and 2nd That the Clerk do also certify to The Governor the names of all the Acting Magistrates of the County

A majority of the acting Magistrates of this County being present the Court proceeded to consider the advice of ^{the Executive} Council to the Clerk of this Court directed date "Executive Department. 29th June 1831" & came to the following resolutions 1st That the Court had a right at their last Term to make the recommendation of persons to be appointed & been imposed Justice of the Peace of this County upon taking the vote of the Court upon this resolution it was as follows to wit - For the Resolution - Alexander P.
