Whereupon Albert Drury having a majority of votes was declared duly elected Constable in the lower district of Nottingham Parish in this County to fill the vacancy created by the failure of James Murdough to qualify the Court being of opinion that the said Drury is a man of honesty probity and good demeanor the said Drury gave bond security and qualified according to Law which bond is ordered to be recorded -
