Yet upon this condition that if the said Benjamin Ross, Sterling Hodge and Benjamin Lewis shall severally ^{on the first day of the next term} make their personal appearance before the Judge of our Circuit Superior, to be held for this County and then and there give such evidence as they and each of them know on behalf of the Commonwealth against John B. Parsons who stands charged with felony and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue -

On the motion of John B. Parsons the prisoner and the Court being of opinion that his case is a bailable one: It is ordered that he be allowed to give bail himself to be bound in the sum of five hundred dollars with two securities in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars each, for his personal appearance before the Judge of our Circuit Superior Court, to be held for this County to answer the felony with which he stands charged -
