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being demanded of him of any thing for himself he had or knew to say why the Court should not proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to Law. he said he had nothing but what he had before said Therefore it is considered by the Court that he be taken from hence to the Jail from whence he came, and that on Tuesday the 20th day of December next between the hours of ten o'clock in the forenoon & four o'clock in the afternoon of the same day. he be taken by the Sheriff of this County to the usual place of execution and then and there be hanged by the neck until he be dead.

Memor. the Court value the said Slave Ben to the sum of four hundred dollars. Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning 9 o'clock.
