Rees, and that the said Comr. examine, state and settle the same and make
report thereof to Court &c.

The Court doth assign Augustin Pope Guardian to Louisa & Marissa, Morrell
and Louisa Morrell infant children of Sally Morrell who said Pope for his Guardian
in fact children of Sally Morrell, and thereupon he gave bond and
security according to Law.

Be it remembered that Henry Beale here in Court acknowledged
himself indebted to John Floyd Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of
Virginia in the sum of one hundred dollars to be levied of his goods and
chattel land and tenements and to the said Governor and his successors for
the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if
