

Committ. to David Jeyner. Recogn. ret. & Cont. till next Court.
 Jeyner who stands charged with stabbing was this day set to the bar
 in custody of the Sheriff of this County (the Court summoned for his examination
 having failed to meet) and for reasons appearing to the Court the examination
 of the said Jeyner is adjourned till the next Court. And on the motion of the
 prisoner the Court being of opinion that this case is a bailable one it is ordered
 that he be allowed to give bail himself to be bound in a recognizance in the
 sum of \$50 with two securities in the sum of \$25 each. Whereupon the
 said Jeyner with Byrd Sumner and John Cobb his securities here
 in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted to John Floyd Esq
 Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his Successors the said
 Jeyner in the sum of fifty dollars and the said Byrd Sumner &
 John Cobb in the sum of twenty five dollars each to be levied of their respec-
 tive good and chattels lands and tenements to be levied by the said Gov-
 ernor his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon
 this condition that if the said Jeyner shall personally appear before
 the Commonwealth's Justice of the Peace for this County at the Court house
 on the first day of July Court next then and there to answer for the charge
 aforesaid and shall do abate by and perform what shall be adjudged by
 the said Court and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said
 Court then the above Recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force
 & virtue.

 \$25 each. Whereupon the said Henry Cobb with Byrd Sumner & John
 Cobb his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves to
 be indebted to John Floyd Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia
 and his Successors the said Henry Cobb in the sum of \$50 and the
 said Byrd Sumner and John Cobb in the sum of \$25 each of their
 respective good & chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to the said
 Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.
 Yet upon this condition that if the said Henry Cobb shall make his
 personal appearance before the Commonwealth's Justice of the Peace
 for this County at the Court house on the first day of July Court



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
