 heretofore awarded in this cause as to the claim or judgment of Charles Surmans
 in the bill referred to and doth adjudge that the said Charles Surmans pay to
 the plaintiff as now asforesaid the sum of twelve dollars & fourteen cents, and the Court
 doth further adjudge, that the injunction asforesaid as to the sum of Eighty six &
 thirty five cents and fifty four dollars forty two cents with interest on eighty six
 dollars thirty five cents from the 1st July 1828 due to Spradley Williams admt
 Betsey Williams dec. be dissolved and that the costs of this suit be equally borne
 between the parties.

Ordered that Lewis C. Trogerant, Stephen Murdaugh & Wells Murfer or any
 two of them let to the Corrat undertakers the necessary repairs to the larger Bridge
 near Maphenburys mill, receive the same when completed & make rep^t &c.

The Court proceeded to appoint a Constable in the ^{Lower} district of St. Lukes Parish
 to supply the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of ^{James M. H.} Leonel Harris and the
 following was the vote of the Court to wit

For James D. Bryant the votes were, James D. Maphenbury, Solomon D. Parker,
 William A. Sparks, Alexander Mynick, Septia Darden, & Benjamin Griffin
 For John R. Williams the votes were, George A. C. Barham, Joseph T. Hland &
 Samuel Drury. James D. Bryant having the largest number of votes was
 declared elected the Court being of opinion that he is a man of honesty, probity &
 good demeanour.
