

Barham & Clements & Leby. On the motion of Edward P. Turner attorney for
Darius Turner he is admitted party ^{off} in this suit.

Benjamin Drake who stands charged on oath by Parmelia Mumford a
free single woman of this County with being the father of her bastard child
this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance, and thereupon
the said Parmelia Mumford being sworn and examined and the said
Drake fully heard the Court from all the circumstances of this case do
adjudge the said Benjamin Drake to be the father of the said bastard
child and that the said child is likely to become chargeable to the County.
Therefore it is ordered that the said Benjamin Drake be charged with the
annual payment of \$20. a year for seven years from this day and that
he be committed to Jail and there safely kept until he shall find
sufficient security himself to be bound in a recognizance in the sum of
one hundred and forty dollars with two securities in the sum of seventy dollars
each and conditioned for the said Drake paying to the Overseers of the Poor
of this County the sum of twenty dollars annually for the term of seven
years from this day or until he be otherwise discharged by due course of law.
Wm. Blythe having been guilty of swearing in the presence and
hearing of the Court. Ordered that the said Wm. Blythe be fined the
sum of eighty three cents for the said Contempt.

Be it remembered that Philip Beale with Joseph Jagers and Gilbert
H. Beale his securities here in Court severally acknowledged himself indebted
to John Floyd Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Beale in the
sum of one hundred dollars and the said Joseph Jagers & Gilbert H.
Beale in the sum of fifty dollars each of their respective good & lawful
lands & tenements to be levied of to the said Governor and his successors for
the use of the Commonwealth rendered.

Yet upon the condition that if the said Philip Beale shall keep
the peace and be of good ^{behavior} ~~security~~ towards this Commonwealth and all its
citizens more especially towards Joseph Jagers of this County then this
recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
James Blythe who stands charged by recognizance for his appearance
here to answer the complaint of Harrison Mumford against him for a
breach of the Peace this day appeared in discharge of his recognizance
and the said Harrison Mumford being sworn and examined It is ordered
that the said James Blythe find security for his keeping the peace towards
all the citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards the said
Harrison Mumford. the said Blythe to be bound in a recognizance in
the sum of \$200 with two securities in the sum of \$50 each.
