of Rebecca Gurley's Guardianship of the Person of Henry Gurley dec^d & report the same
to the Court &c.

On the motion of Thomas Bewan Licentiate is granted leave to keep an Ordinary at
his dwelling house in this County till the 1st day of May next upon his paying the fees
& entering into bond with security according to Law. He appearing to the
Court that the said Bewan is a man of good character and not addicted to
drunkenness or gaming.

Ordered that the Est. of William Jenkins dec^d be committed to the hands of

Leon Brown Stff of this County to be administered according to Law.
