And it is ordered that the said Samuel Wick deliver up the said property to the shff and that the shff make sale of the same as well as the property attached by the Constable, and out of the monies arising therefrom pay and satisfy the two judgments this day rendered against the said Barnes one in favour of William T Blom and the other in favour of Nicholas Sparks. and the balance of any pay to the shff in discharge of this judgment & make return to Court.
