The Court are unanimous in recommending a levy to be made at the next June Court of one moiety of the expenses & incurred in rebuilding the said Court house, and the moiety of the said expenses to be levied at the June Court 1834.

The said Court are also unanimously of opinion that the walls of the said Court house should be of brick, the covering to be of slate or tin. - the Windows & door sills of stone. and that the same should be attached to the End of the Clerk's Office fronting John Mergenthal's Lot. - And they therefore appoint Clements Rochelle, Jer. Cobb, James Rochelle, Joseph T. Lang, John Mergenthal, James D. Mergenthal & Saml Brown to draft and report a plan to the next Court for rebuilding the said Court house -
