At a Court called and held for the County of Southampton on the 16th day of February 1833 pursuant to an Act of the General Assembly passed the 13th day of February 1814 entitled "An act to explain & amend an Act reducing into one the several Acts concerning Fugitive Entries and Detainers."

This day came James Wick by his Attorney and presented his ^{of unlawful detainer} complaint against Allen Bradshaw. Whereupon the defendant appeared by his Attorney and thereupon a jury ^{selected by lot and} composed of twelve of the freeholders summoned by the Sheriff to wit James Bell, Elijah Kelms, Samuel James, Benjamin Simmons, Nicholas C. Williams, John Simmons, Robert Drury, ^{Samuel Bond, Gilbert Drury,} Patrick H. Rollings, William D. Hoist & Joseph Little who being sworn according to Law upon their oaths returned a verdict in the following words to wit. We the jury find that the defendant did at the time of the exhibition of the complaint filed in this cause hold possession of the tenement therein mentioned against the consent of the plaintiff. That the said defendant ^{not} held the possession thereof against the consent of the plaintiff for three years next before the exhibition of said complaint and that the plaintiff hath the right of possession in the tenement aforesaid. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover possession of the tenement aforesaid with full costs. And thereupon a writ of Habeas facias possessionem is awarded the plaintiff rule &c.
