of \$15 for the space of two years and that he pay the same to the Treasurer of  
the Poor of Sufepa County.

Be it remembered that Mary Brakes, Thomas R Gray & Richd' Johnson  
appeared in open Court & acknowledged themselves to be indebted to John Floyd  
Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the sum of \$50: and the said Mary Brakes in the sum of  
\$50: and the said Thomas R Gray & Richd' Johnson in the sum of \$35:  
each of their respective goods & chattels lands & tenements to be levied and to  
the said Governor this Surety for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.  
Yet upon the condition that of the said Mary Brakes shall make her per-  
sonal appearance before the Justice of the Court of Southampton County on  
the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April next and shall abide by and perform the order  
of the Court which may be made in this behalf and shall not depart without  
the leave of the said Court and in the mean time shall keep the peace and  
be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth more espe-  
cially towards Emma Doyal of this County when this recognizance shall end  
or else to remain in full force.
