the Poor of Sussex County.

Be it remembered that Mary Drake, Thomas R. Gray & Rich^d Johnson
appeared in open Court & acknowledged themselves to be indebted to John H. Pope
Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Mary Drake in the sum of
\$50. and the said Thomas R. Gray & Rich^d Johnson in the sum of
each of their respective goods & chattels lands & Tenements to be levied and to
the said Governor this Sumpson for the use of the Commonwealth ordered.
Yet upon the condition that of the said Mary Drake shall make her per-
sonal appearance before the Justice of the Court of Southampton County on
the 1st day of April Term next and shall abide by and perform the order
of the Court which may be made in this behalf and shall not depart without
the leave of the said Court and in the mean time shall keep the peace and
be of good behaviour towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth more espe-
cially towards Emma Royal of this County then this recognizance shall void
or else to remain in full force.
