On motion of the deft Swinans it is ordered that the Judgment entered in this cause at March Court 1832 be corrected so as to read that the Plaintiff recover against the defendant Nathaniel Swinans as administrator of Horrell Reese sen^r the sum of \$240.73 cents with legal interest from the 19th January 1831 till paid & the costs. To be levied of the goods & chattels of the said Horrell Reese sen^r in the hands of the said Defendant to be administered.

Cummings & son v. Sally Everett. Lely. The deft being dead on the motion of the pliff by consent of Can. Bowers Shiff & home of the Estate of the said Sally Everett it is ordered that this suit stand and be revived against the said Bowers Committee as aforesaid.

Commonwealth v. Levi Waller & John Nicholas. Infor. Jury sworn to try the issue with James M. Glenn, Edmund Williams, Peter Sumner, James Bell, Richard Moore, Jason Rowe, Thomas L. Reese, Mills Williams, Joseph Soyner, John Reese, Hardy Soyner, & George Blunt returned a verdict against the deft. Judgment rendered accordingly with costs & c.
