James Smith vs Peter J. Leby - On motion for reasons appearing to the Court, by an interlocutory decree in this case, Ordered that the Court appointed to make sale of the slaves of the Estate of Peter J. Leby do. be summoned to the next Court to make their report and to pay the proportion of the sales to which Peter J. Leby is entitled of said slaves into Court subject to the future order of the Court. The Court doth appoint Lewis S. Tregvant (farmer), a school commissioner for the County in the room of ^{Alfred} ~~William~~ Warden removed, and it is ordered that the said Tregvant be served with a copy of this order.

On motion of Murdough & Tregvant Merchants. Ordered that they have leave to retail spirituous liquors at their store in Jerusalem in this County. It appearing to the Court that they are men of good character.

Benjamin Baines, John Baines and William Joyner charged with murder committed upon the body of Godwin Arlis were again set to the bar in custody of the jailer of this County and their respective sundry other witnesses were sworn & examined as well on behalf of the Commonwealth as the prisoners and the prisoners being fully heard by Counsel on consideration whereof and of all the circumstances of the case the Court are of opinion and do accordingly order that the prisoners be discharged from further prosecution for the said Offense.

Elias Clark & Richard Robertson who stand charged with murder committed upon the body of Godwin Arlis were again set to the bar in custody of the jailer of this County and their respective sundry other witnesses were sworn and examined as well on behalf of the Commonwealth as the prisoners and the prisoners were fully heard by Counsel. On consideration whereof and of all the circumstances of the case the Court are of opinion and do accordingly order that the prisoners be discharged from further prosecution for the said Offense.

Ordered that the unadministered Estate of John Fort do. be committed to the hands of Ben Barron Shff of this County for administration according to Law. Ordered that Mr Barron shall settle an account of said Estate on the 1st of June next. & make report &c.

Ordered that Richard Jordan Guardian to Elias Clark pay out of the principal of his bond Est. the fees of the Counsel employed to defend him on a charge of felony.

On motion of Thomas L. Jones who produced the Shffs receipt for the license imposed by Law License is granted him to keep the house of private Entertainment at his house in Jerusalem his May Court next.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in course.
