Be it remembered that *Wells Eley* was *Samuel M Pond*, *Robert Drewry*
 and *John Exum* — has been here in Court severally acknowledged
 themselves indebted to *John Floyd Esq* Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia
 that to wit the said *Wells Eley* in the sum of five hundred dollars —
 and the said — each of them
 has purchased or shall purchase — each of them
 respective goods and chattels land, and then intends to be devised and to the said
 Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth. Rendered. Yet upon
 the condition that whereas *Wells Eley* a person supposed to be of unsound
 mind is confined in the Jail of this County until he can be removed to
 the public hospital for the maintenance and cure of persons of unsound
 mind in the City of Williamsburg but at the request of the said *Saml*
M Pond, *Robert Drewry* and *John Exum* — the said *Wells*
Eley has been delivered to them. If therefore the said *Samuel M Pond*,
Robert Drewry and *John Exum* shall take proper care of the said *Wells*
Eley and cause him to be kept secure and restrained from going at large
 until he shall be restored to his senses then — the above
 obligation to be void or else to remain in full force.
